Security Information**

In the interest of providing a safe and secure experience for our students and spectators at our events held in the Great Oak Stadium, GOHS Administration has instituted the following guidelines upon entering the stadium:

- No re-entry for ALL students and spectators
- Prohibited ALL outside food and drinks
- No bags and backpacks larger than a purse
- ALL acceptable bags, backpacks and purses are subject to search
- Possible wand for weapons by school personnel upon entry into the stadium
- No loitering and standing along fences surrounding the stadium

Wolfpack Athletics Spectators are encouraged to:

- Minimize the number of personal items they bring to the game.
- Bags that are fully packed take longer to search; clear bags and those packed loosely are more easily examined.
- There is no check-in location for prohibited bags or items at Great Oak Stadium
